- The first day of school for students is Wednesday September 8, 2021
- School hours are from 7:25am 1:55pm
- All students who attend school in-person MUST wear a mask during school hours, while at the bus stop and while on the school bus.
- All students who attend school in-person MUST wear the established school uniform. The BHES school uniform is:
 - Navy blue pants, shorts or jumpers
 - Navy, light blue or white polo shirts
 - o Navy, light blue or white socks
 - o Belt
 - Close-toed shoes

BHES Digital Learning Tools

- PreK and Kindergarten students will utilize iPads in the classroom
- 1st grade students will return the iPad that was assigned to them as kindergartners and will receive a Chromebook. The 1st grade device exchange date is Wednesday August 25th from 10:00am-1:00pm.
- Students in 2nd 6th grades will utilize the Chromebooks that were assigned to them last school year.
- All students who are newly enrolled at Bradbury Heights and transferred from another PGCPS school should bring the device that was assigned to them at the previous PGCPS school.



- If the device your child received has been damaged, please email Mrs. Andrea Batson at andrea.batson@pgcps.org. There is a \$30 fee per item for all damaged equipment. Only money orders are taken and should be made payable to PGCPS.
