

# Prince George's 3D Scholars Program

Through a groundbreaking partnership, Prince George's County Public Schools (PGCPS), Prince George's Community College (PGCC) and University of Maryland University College (UMUC) will offer a special dual enrollment program for PGCPS students. Students earn credits towards an associate's degree while in high school, then immediately transition to PGCC and UMUC at a highly-reduced cost to earn a bachelor's degree in one of three courses of study: **Business Administration, Cyber Security or Criminal Justice.**

### *Do I Have What It Takes?*

#### Potential 3D Scholars Must:

- Be PGCPS 9th, 10th or 11th-grader by September 2019
- Have a 2.5 GPA per application specifications
- Meet minimum score requirements per grade level on PSAT (given Fall 2018), Accuplacer, SAT or ACT
- Demonstrate characteristics that help predict future success with college-level work

### *How Do I Apply?*

#### Application Process:

- Complete the 3D Scholars Program Application by November 16, 2018
- Have two of your core subject area teachers complete a 3D Scholars Program Student Evaluation Form
- Submit a 500-word essay as directed in the application Only 50 seats are available! Qualified applicants will be screened by grade level, strength of application packet and selected by lottery
- Selected students must transfer to 3D Scholars Program site at Charles H. Flowers High School
