All students registering for Evening school must contact the Professional School Counselor at their base school to obtain registration paperwork before coming to the registrations noted above.

#### GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

#### **Program Description:**

Evening High School (EHS) is an alternative school program designed to provide educational opportunities needed to complete a student's pathway to earning a high school diploma. Students enrolled in the EHS program may have had their education interrupted for some reason or may wish to enrich or accelerate their regular day school program. In order to attend EHS, students must be at least sixteen years old and older having completed eighth grade. Students may attend EHS in lieu of attending day school or they may enroll concurrently.

<u>Regular Evening High School Student</u> - A student who is not enrolled in day school at the time of registration. In order to register for classes in the Evening School program, these students will need a copy of their Custom Transcript, PDS card with tallies completed through the end of the previous school year, standardized testing information to include H.S.A. and PARCC scores, 504 plan or IEP, if applicable, immunization records, Birth Certificate, and Proof of Residency (Lease or Deed and 2 current pieces of mail dated within 30 days of registration).

<u>Concurrently Enrolled Student</u> - A student who is enrolled in a day school program at the time of registration and who wishes to take a class(es) in the Evening High School program at the same time. In order to register for classes in the Evening School program, these students will need a completed Concurrent Registration form, signed by the student's Principal and Professional School Counselor.

#### **Starting and Ending Dates:**

Second semester classes in Evening High School begin on January 29, 2018 and end on May 11, 2018.

#### **Types of Credit:**

Original Credit- courses taken for the FIRST time by the student.

<u>Repeat Credit</u> - courses that the student has previously taken, i.e. student was previously enrolled in a course having the same course number.

#### **Types of Classes:**

<u>Term length classes (1 credit courses</u>) - One credit courses in English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies that are taught in a semester through extended class hours and accelerated study. They either meet on Monday and Wednesday evening or on Thursday and Thursday evening, from January 29<sup>th</sup> thru May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

Period 1: 5:15 PM - 7:10 PM Period 2: 7:20 PM - 9:10 PM

<u>Semester length classes (1/2 credit courses)</u> - meet on Monday and Wednesday evening or on Tuesday and Thursday evening, from January 29<sup>th</sup> thru May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

Period 2: 7:20 PM - 8:10 PM Period 3: 8:20 PM - 9:10 PM

<u>CANCELLATION OF CLASSES</u> - If classes are cancelled at an Evening center due to insufficient enrollment, students may transfer to another Evening center where the class is offered.

#### **TUITION AND FEES**

All fees are due at the time of registration. Payment is to be in the form of a <u>money order only</u> in the exact amount made payable to Prince George's County Public Schools. No cash and no personal checks will be accepted.

<u>Students who withdraw from their day school program to attend evening school exclusively will pay the \$35.00 registration fee and \$65.00 course fee only.</u>

#### **TUITION WAIVERS**

The tuition may be waived by <u>25% of the full price of one course</u> per student who qualify for free or reduced lunch only. Completed waiver forms signed by the base school principal/designee must be submitted at the time of registration. <u>Only PGCPS students are eligible for tuition waivers.</u>

#### LUNCH

Lunch is available at each center, free of charge to the student. Students are also permitted to bring their own lunch. No student will be permitted to leave the campus to get lunch.
