All students registering for Evening school must contact the Professional School Counselor at their base school to obtain registration paperwork before coming to the registrations noted above.

GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

Program Description: Evening High School (EHS) is an alternative school program designed to provide educational opportunities needed to complete a student’s pathway to earning a high school diploma. Students enrolled in the EHS program may have had their education interrupted for some reason or may wish to enrich or accelerate their regular day school program. In order to attend EHS, students must be at least sixteen years old or older having completed eighth grade. Students may attend EHS in lieu of attending day school or they may enroll concurrently.

Starting and Ending Dates:

Second semester classes in Evening High School begin on February 3, 2020 and end on May 21, 2020.

Types of Credit:

Original Credit- courses taken for the **FIRST** time by the student.

Repeat Credit - courses that the student has previously taken (i.e. student was previously enrolled in a course having the same course number).

Types of Classes:

Term length classes - One credit courses in English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies that are taught in a semester through extended class hours and accelerated study. They either meet on Monday and Wednesday evenings or on Thursday and Thursday evenings, from September 16th thru January 24th, 2020.

Period 1: 5:15 PM - 7:10 PM

Period 2: 7:20 PM - 9:10 PM

Semester length classes (1/2 credit courses) - meet on Monday and Wednesday evenings or on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, from February 3, 2020 and end on May 21, 2020.

Period 2: 7:20 PM - 8:15 PM

Period 3: 8:20 PM - 9:10 PM

REGULAR EVENING HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT - A student who is not enrolled in day school at the time of registration. In order to register for classes in the Evening School program, these students will need a copy of their universal transcript, PDS card with tallies completed through the end of the previous school year, standardized testing information to include H.S.A. and PARCC scores, 504 plan or IEP, if applicable, immunization records, Birth Certificate, and Proof of Residency (Lease or Deed and 2 current pieces of mail dated within 30 days of registration).

CONCURRENTLY ENROLLED STUDENT - A student who is enrolled on a day school program at the time of registration and who wishes to take a class(es) in the Evening High School program at the same time. In order to register for classes in the Evening School program, these students will need a copy of their universal transcript and a completed Concurrent Registration form, signed by the student’s Principal and Professional School Counselor.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES - If classes are cancelled at a center due to insufficient enrollment, students may transfer to another center where the class is offered.

TUITION AND FEES

All fees are due at the time of registration. Payment is to be in the form of a money order only in the exact amount made payable to Prince George’s County Public Schools. No cash and no personal checks will be accepted. There will be NO refund request accepted after the 1st week of classes. Requests for refunds must be submitted on the appropriate form with the ORIGINAL RECEIPT, to the Evening High School site where the student is registered. If a refund is granted, it will take a minimum of ten weeks to process.

*The \$35.00 registration fee & \$25.00 late fee is non-refundable.

Students who withdraw from their day school program to attend evening school exclusively will pay the \$35.00 registration fee and \$65.00 course fee only.

TUITION WAIVERS

The tuition may be waived by 25% of the full price of one course per student who qualify for free or reduced lunch only. Completed waiver forms signed by the base school principal/designee must be submitted at the time of registration. Only PGCPS students are eligible for tuition waivers.

LUNCH

Lunch is available at each center, free of charge to the student. Students are also permitted to bring their own lunch. No student will be permitted to leave the campus to get lunch.
