Begin by visiting collegeboard.org

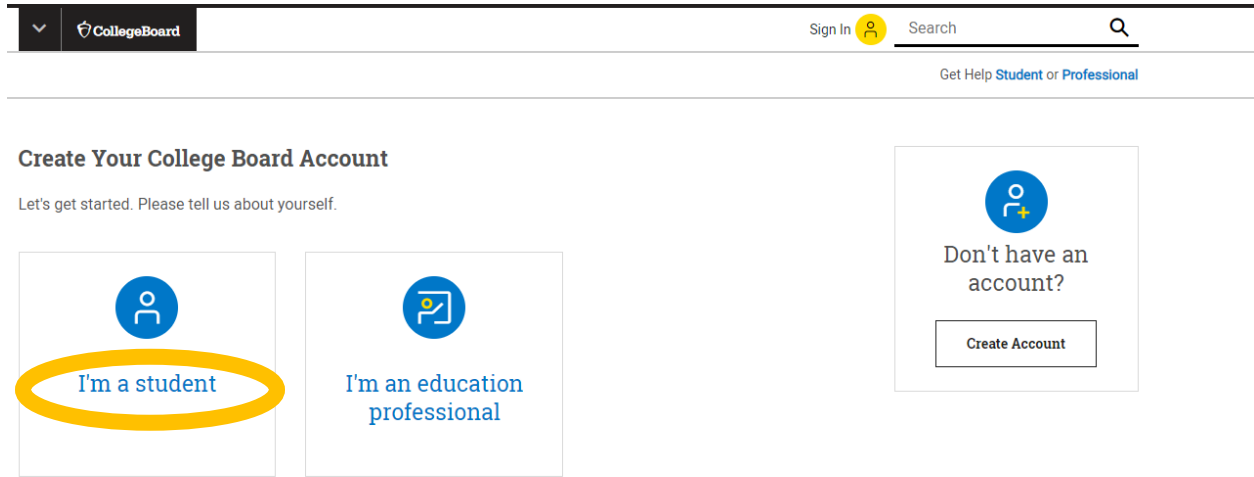
Select "Don't have an account? Sign Up"
